Hooson Award



The Hooson Award is a financial grant for young people who are hoping to develop a career in agriculture, horticulture or the rural sector.

To qualify you should originate from Kent, be under the age of 21 and either be in further education or planning to enrol for an agricultural qualification or apprenticeship. We require a written submission explaining what you will be studying, why you want to complete the course, what you hope to do in the future and how any funding received will be used. A shortlist will be selected by the KCAS Education and Awards Committee, after which applicants may be required to attend an interview before a final decision is made.

The successful applicant will receive **£500** which is intended to assist the student to pay for their future studies. They will also be invited to provide a presentation at the December KCAS Council meeting.

Applications must be received by Friday 29 September 2017.
