**Palemakers competition rules.**

The competition will take place at the Kent County Showground on Saturday 7th July from 10am.

1. Competitors will be provided with shaved wood in a crate, a brake and table, a bundler and string. All wood will be 1 metre in length, good quality pale wood.
2. Competitors will have 40 minutes in which to make as many bundles of pales as they can. Pales ideally to be 10-12cm (4"-4 1/2 ") in circumference, tipped three sides on the flats to a point not more than 4cm (1 1/2") long and bundled in 25's with two strings. Bundles to be numbered for anonymity when being judged.
3. Pales will be judged for quality and will be awarded points to a maximum of 20 points. Points will be awarded for the quantity of pales made in the specified time up to a maximum of 20 points and the competitor with the highest combined total will be the winner.
4. Prize money will be awarded to the first four competitors as follows. 1st £200 2nd £125 3rd £75. There will also be special prize of £50 each for the highest scorer over 65 and under 25 in age. Presentation of prizes will be at 4pm in the Woodland Ring.
5. The judge is Steve Homewood.
6. Entry forms must be received by the Kent Coppice Workers Co-operative at address below by July 2nd. Competitors will receive one ticket for entry to the show on the day of the competition.
7. Entries can be made on the day, however no entry ticket for the Show will be provided.
