The term study includes apprenticeships, college and degree courses and practical courses completed within the workplace.

Subjects which will be considered (but are not exclusive) include the following areas:

- Woodland and forestry management
- Arboriculture
- Tree planting and or preservation
- Wildlife conservation
- Woodland rural crafts
- Coppicing

The chosen applicant will be awarded the R.D Keeler Trophy at the 2019 Kent County Show on Friday 5th July. The recipient will hold the trophy for one year.
