HERITAGE TRANSPORT SHOW – AUTOJUMBLE RULES AND REGULATIONS

STAND PRICES

Autojumble plots are charged at £25.00 (plus VAT – Total cost £30.00).
All Autojumble plots are outside and will have approximately 7m frontage.

STAND CLASSIFICATION

Autojumble plots are available to sell any second hand / used machinery or part items only. If you are selling any other products please contact Amy Marsh in the Show Office for a trade stand form.

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL ACT 2001

If you regularly trade in second hand goods you will need to register with KCC to trade at the Heritage Transport Show.

SHOW TIMES

All stands must be in place by 9.15am and cannot be moved until 4.00pm. For any autojumble stands arriving later than 9.15am, space may not be guaranteed.

The Kent Showground is open from 7.30am to 6.00pm on Saturday, 4 April 2020.

The Show will be open to the general public from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

TICKETS

All exhibits will be given the appropriate vehicle and admission passes to gain access to the Showground. Additional tickets can be purchased at the pre-show rate of £9.00 per adult (£12.00 on the gate), under 14's free, pre-show rate only available until Friday 3 April 2020.

Tickets can also be purchased from www.kentshowground.co.uk or on the Autojumble Stand form.

INSURANCE

All stands must hold a copy of their public liability insurance on their stand at the Heritage Transport Show. This may be checked by the appropriate steward.

MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES

The road traffic act now applies to all places to which the public have access, therefore no unlicensed or under-age driving is permitted.

The speed limit on the Showground is 10 mph. This applies to ALL vehicles on the Showground. The one way system of the Showground must be observed at all times.

Movement of all vehicles is restricted to travel to and from the ring or for permitted display purposes.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The placing of stands will be entirely at the discretion of the Society and their Stewards, although every endeavour will be made to meet any request made by an exhibitor.

No parking is permitted outside the entrance of the Maidstone Exhibition Hall or along the side of the buildings past 9.30am as this space is required for display purposes.

All persons must pay proper regard to the Stewards' instructions and should conduct themselves in a manner, which will not inconvenience other persons at the event.
